## **Two-week Outlook Effective August 8, 2022**

The Central Avenue Improvements Project Team will provide this progress report so that you can stay up-to-date on what's happening in the project area and what could impact your travel in and around the area. 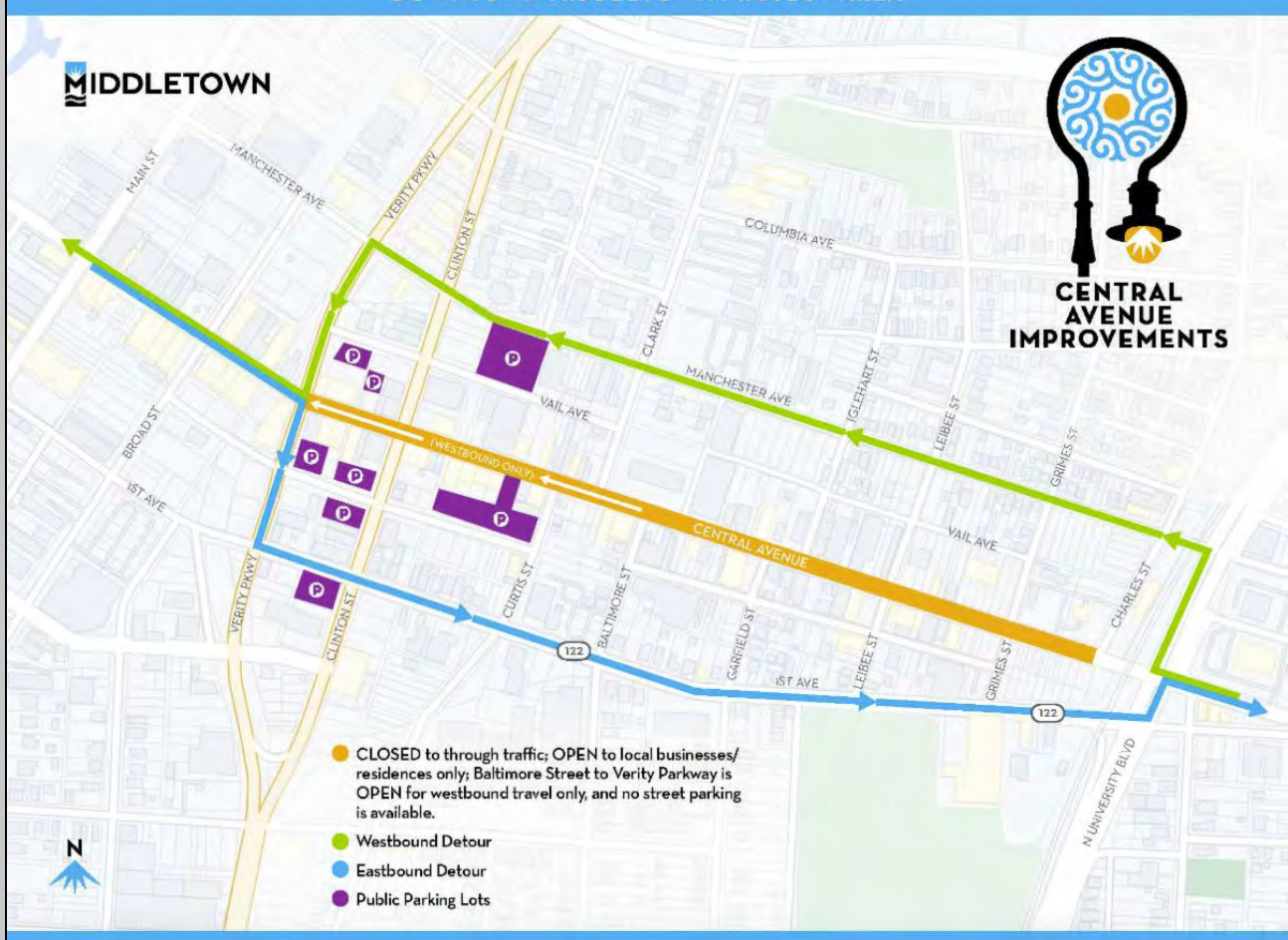
### **Scheduled Work (Weather Permitting)**

- Install light pole foundations in sidewalk from Charles to Baltimore Street; pedestrian access maintained; be alert to workers in walkways
- Install electric pull boxes from Charles to Baltimore Street
- Install sewer pipe lining from Garfield to Clinton Street
- Install storm sewer pipe and manholes from Curtis to Clinton Street
- Install storm sewer catch basin at Clinton Street
- Install sidewalk from Charles to Baltimore Street on north side then south side
- Recoat manholes from Charles to Leiber Street

### **Completed Work**

- Removed road pavement from Baltimore Street to Verity Parkway on the south side of Central Avenue
- Connected new water service from Baltimore Street to Verity Parkway, which completes the installation of new water service through the project area
- Installed sewer pipe lining from Curtis to Clinton Street
- Installed electric pull boxes from Charles to Baltimore Street on north side
- Installed some light pole foundations in sidewalk from Charles to Baltimore Street

**Impacts To Travel  
Now through December 1, Weather Permitting**



- LOCAL access is OPEN for businesses and residents from Charles Street to Verity Parkway (now through December 1).
- NO THROUGH TRAFFIC is permitted from Charles Street to Verity Parkway (now through December 1).
- Central Avenue from Baltimore Street to Verity Parkway is open to westbound traffic only. No on-street parking is available.
- Pedestrian access is OPEN throughout the project area.

The Central Avenue Improvements Project will make a generational transformation in the city's historic downtown district by revitalizing a key section of Central Avenue within the city's urban core. The project will modernize outdated infrastructure that will help attract and retain businesses and benefit residents and visitors of the downtown area for years to come.
