Signs of Progress: Fresh Pavement and Sidewalks





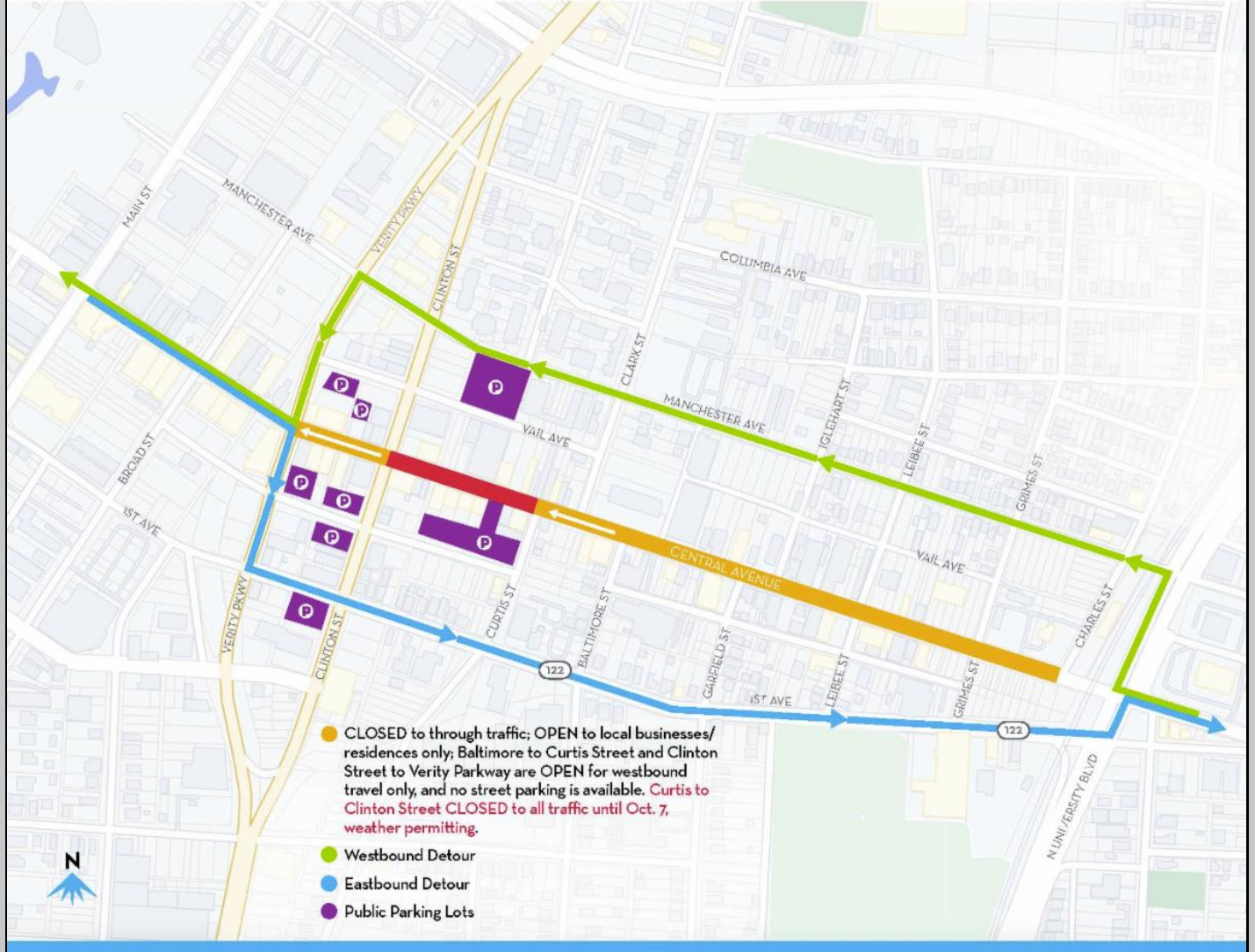
Scheduled Work (Weather Permitting)

- Install pavement base and grade roadway from Baltimore to Clinton Street
- Install irrigation lining from Baltimore to Clinton Street
- Clean up and fill in areas between new sidewalks and buildings from Charles to Baltimore Street
- Install curb from Baltimore to Clinton Street
- Install sidewalk paver bricks from Charles to Baltimore Street

Completed Work

- Poured concrete and prepared sidewalk for paver bricks from Charles to Baltimore Street
- Installed drains and manholes from Baltimore to Clinton Street
- Installed pavement base and drains from Baltimore to Curtis Street

Impacts To Travel
Now through October 7, Weather Permitting



- LOCAL access is OPEN for businesses and residents from Charles Street to Verity Parkway (now through December 1).
- NO THROUGH TRAFFIC is permitted from Charles Street to Verity Parkway (now through December 1).
- Central Avenue from Baltimore Street to Verity Parkway is open to westbound traffic only, except as noted on the above map. No on-street parking is available.
- Pedestrian access is OPEN throughout the project area.

The Central Avenue Improvements Project will make a generational transformation in the city's historic downtown district by revitalizing a key section of Central Avenue within the city's urban core. The project will modernize outdated infrastructure that will help attract and retain businesses and benefit residents and visitors of the downtown area for years to come.
