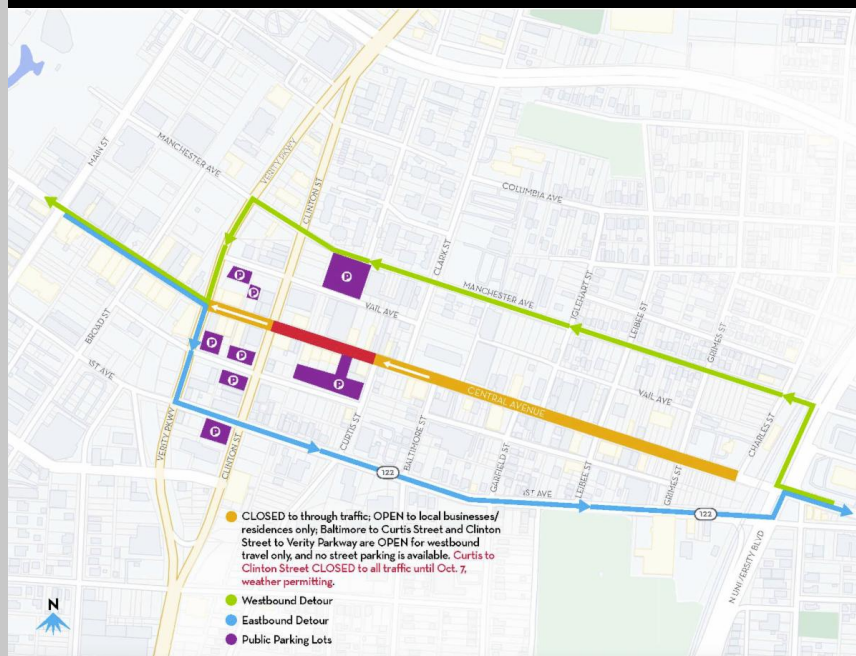
ROAD WORK TO IMPACT TRAVEL ON CENTRAL AVE.

Beginning today, Central Avenue from Baltimore Street to west of Curtis Street will re-open to west-bound local traffic only. Please travel with caution as the surface is gravel. Work that was taking place here will shift one block west.

From now until October 7, Central Avenue from west of Curtis Street to the middle of the Clinton Street intersection will be closed to all vehicles. No travel will be permitted in this block. Through traffic should continue to follow the detours shown below.

During the temporary road closure, crews will be preparing the surface for new pavement and installing new drains and curbs as part of the Central Avenue Improvement Project.
