## **Road Construction Alert Effective November 18, 2022**

### **CENTRAL AVENUE IS NOW OPEN**

Central Avenue is now open for two-way local travel. Detours for through traffic will remain posted. Please be advised work will continue through the Central Avenue corridor for the remainder of the year, weather permitting. Partial road closures and lane restrictions should be expected during work hours.

#### **Here's What To Expect**

##### **Ongoing work includes:**

- Install sidewalk and base for paver bricks between Clinton Street and Verity Parkway
- Install paver bricks between Curtis and Clinton Streets
- Preparing for traffic signal installation
- Rehab sewer using trenchless technology

##### **Upcoming work items through the end of the year (weather permitting):**

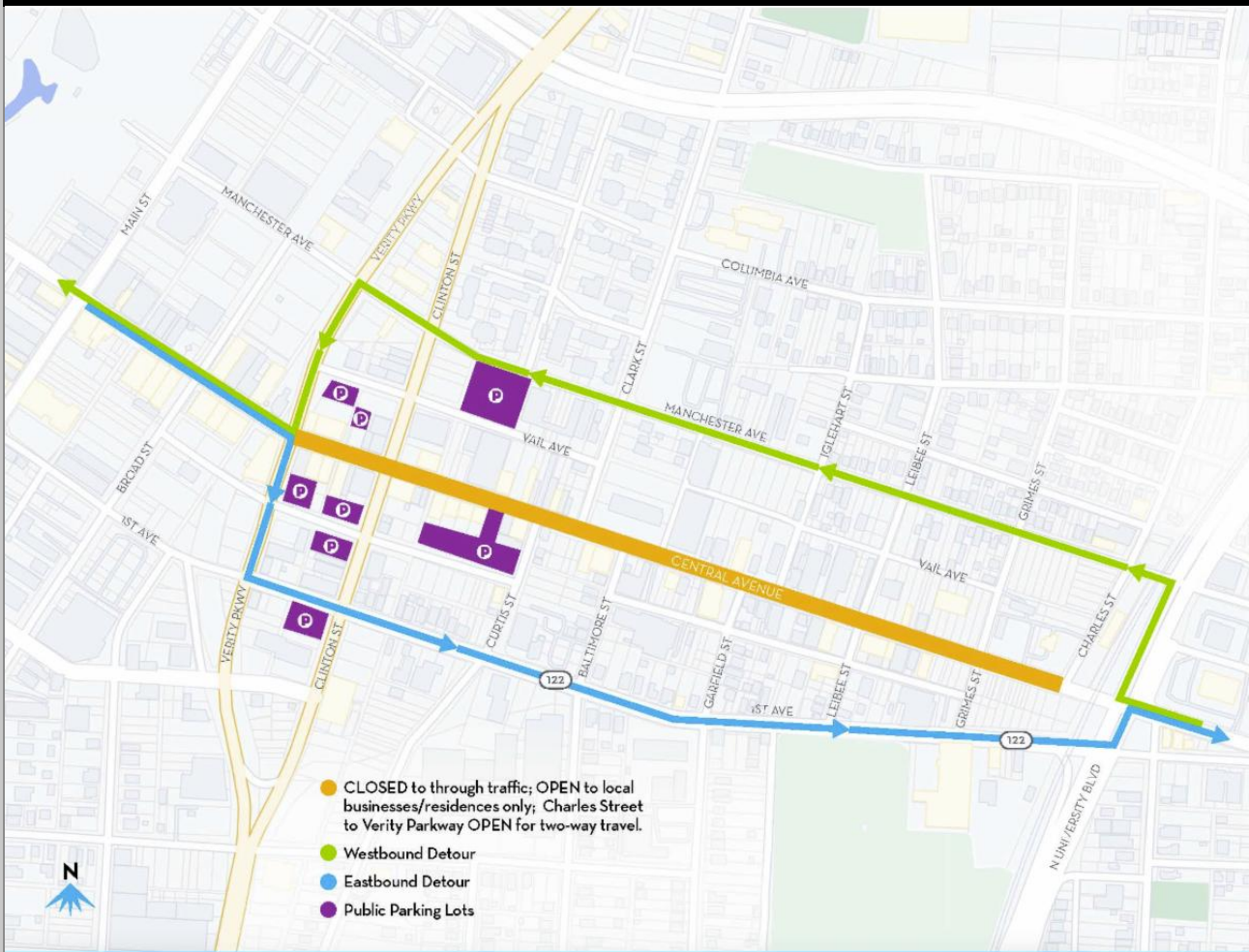
- Install paver bricks between Clinton Street and Verity Parkway
- Install street trees and miscellaneous landscape plantings
- Install temporary street lights (includes reinstalling 15 salvaged street lights)

##### **Work to be completed in 2023:**

- Install permanent street lights – delivery of street light poles has been delayed until the end of January
- Install traffic signal lights at Clinton Street and Verity Parkway intersections
- Plant all landscaping
- Install final pavement
- Paint pavement striping and install signs
- Install benches, trash cans and bike stands
