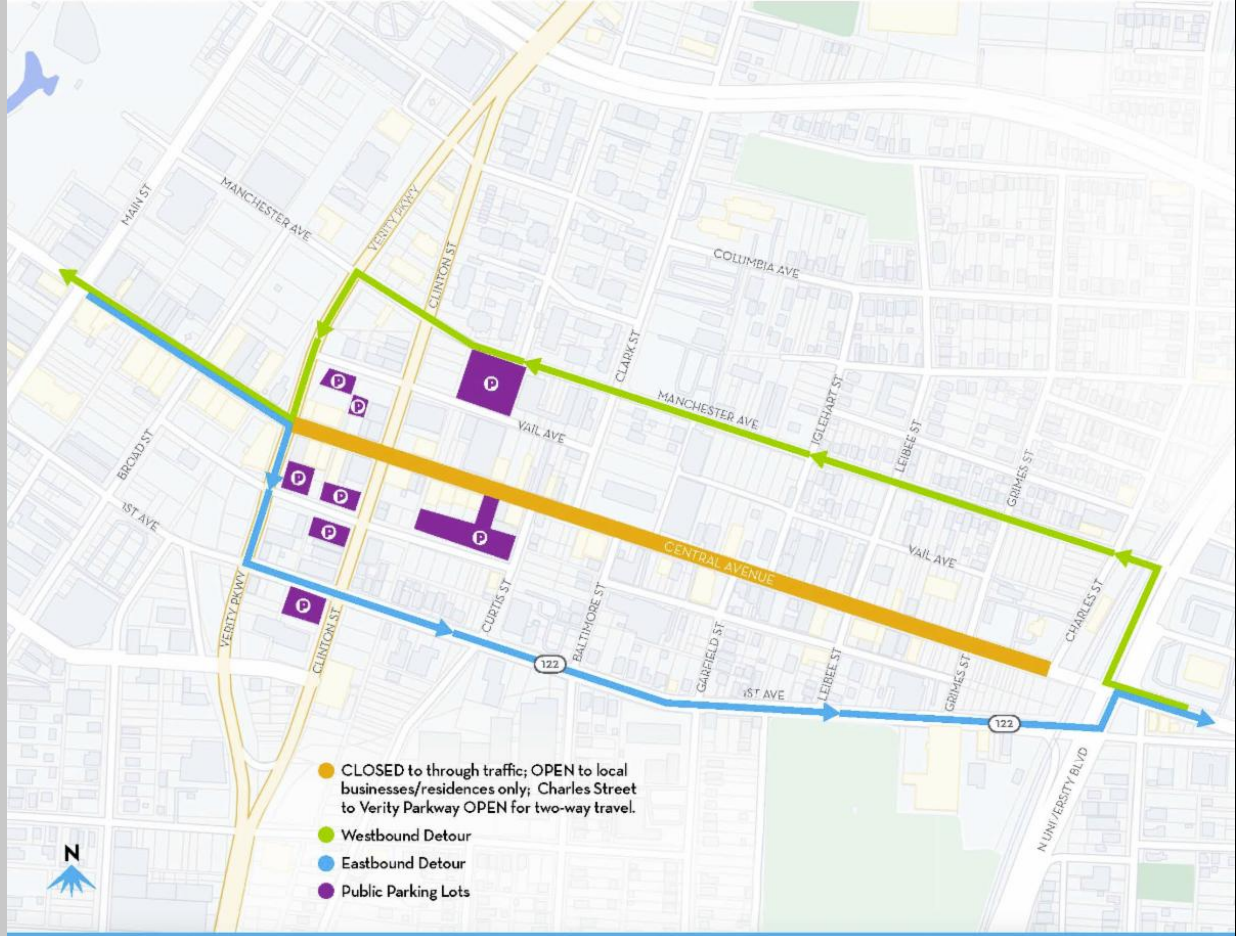
Scheduled Work (Weather Permitting Through Winter)

- Pour concrete walkway at Central Avenue and Verity Parkway
- Install paver bricks for the sidewalk from Clinton Street to Verity Parkway
- Install traffic signal light poles at Clinton Street and Verity Parkway
- Install temporary lighting along Central Avenue throughout improvement area to use until permanent poles arrive
- Install irrigation from Clinton Street to Verity Parkway
- Install permanent road signs

Completed Work

- Paved asphalt from Clinton Street to Verity Parkway
- Installed electric wiring and bases for lighting from Clinton Street to Verity Parkway
- Installed electric wiring and bases for traffic signals at Central Avenue intersections of Clinton Street and Verity Parkway
- Installed sidewalk paver bricks from Baltimore to Clinton Street
- Poured concrete walk from Clinton Street to Verity Parkway
- Painted temporary traffic lines from Clinton Street to Verity Parkway
- Installed traffic signal bases at Clinton Street
- Laid topsoil, planted trees and mulched from Charles to Clinton Street
- Covered additional old coal chutes with steel plates
- Added temporary asphalt around manhole covers for winter

**Impacts To Travel
Now through February 2023, Weather Permitting**



- LOCAL access is OPEN for businesses and residents from Charles Street to Verity Parkway (now through February).
- Partial closures and lane restrictions should be expected during work hours from Charles Street to Verity Parkway (now through May). Detours for through traffic will remain posted.
- Pedestrian access is OPEN throughout the project area.

The Central Avenue Improvements Project will make a generational transformation in the city's historic downtown district by revitalizing a key section of Central Avenue within the city's urban core. The project will modernize outdated infrastructure that will help attract and retain businesses and benefit residents and visitors of the downtown area for years to come.
